

WTC Tragedy: Candle Light Vigil

An estimated 2,000 folks attended the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights Candle Light Vigil held 7:00 p.m. Saturday, September 15th at Depken Field at the corner of Route 17 and Franklin Avenue.

The program included a Boy & Girl Scout Honor Guard, Pledge of Allegiance, Invocation by Rev. Fred W. Diekman (*First Reformed Church*), with comments by Mayor William J. Torre and Assemblywoman and Former Mayor Rose Marie Heck.

It was announced that the Hasbrouck Heights Police and Fire Departments had responded to the scene at the World Trade Center.

Officials from the Borough Council and Board of Education were introduced. Several individuals and organizations were recognized for their contributions in quickly organizing this event.

The Scout Color Guard then lead the Candle Light Walk around the field concluding with Benediction in the center of the football field.

Approximately a ton of food and provisions were also collected by the Department of Public Works.
